## **DEVOTIONS DURING LENT**

Friends, this year during Lent you are invited to read the story of Jesus's last week leading up to his crucifixion. Below you will find a reading schedule of daily readings progressing through Luke's retelling of this time. From Mondays through Saturdays, you will read brief passages from Luke, and on Sunday you will review and read again what you read during the week. The story concludes before Holy Week. During Holy Week, we will read significant passages about Jesus's crucifixion to invite us to contemplate what we commemorate that week.

Read these passages aloud. You may read them alone or with others, but let your voice and ears be part of this. Discuss what catches your attention. Linger over what causes you to wonder. Sit with the questions it stirs up in you. Let this practice help us all to re-center ourselves around God's self-giving love.
