A walkie-talkie is provided should you need to reach a teacher or director during this time. Thank You.

#### DEACON'S FUND COLLECTION

Today is our bi-monthly collection for the Deacon's fund. The money raised for the Deacon's Fund helps us care directly for persons with unmet needs which may be the result of unemployment or underemployment, a utility bill, medical bill, or support to enable you to see a counselor, therapist, or spiritual director. As stated in the Operating Procedures of the Wyckoff Reformed Church, the fund is to be used "primarily for special emergency needs of members of The Wyckoff Reformed Church, and other individuals in need in Wyckoff, New Jersey, and the nearby surrounding areas of Bergen and Passaic Counties. In unusual circumstances aid may be provided outside this area with the approval of the Board of Deacons." We want to remind you, if you have an emergency need or know of someone who does, please speak to Andy or any of the deacons. All requests will be held in strict confidence. It is not too late to sign up for a One Another group! These will be small group gatherings, sustained through the fall, where we can learn each other's names and stories, and share food, prayer, and conversation together. Groups will meet at different times, frequencies, and locations—generally in the homes of group hosts. It will be a place where you can know and be known, where you can give and receive encouragement, support, and love. It will be a place to both talk about and practice living out Jesus' command to love one another. #### OCTOBER WALK-IN DINNER

The next walk-in dinner that Wyckoff Reformed Church will prepare and serve is scheduled for Saturday, October 14th. Through your support, we are able to continue this much needed ministry to those experiencing food insecurity. We need at least 15 volunteers to assist with the food pickup, the food preparation and the delivering and serving of the meal. Family Promise says they are now serving on average 200 people each day, but when we served in August we gave out 276 meals. Food pickup from ShopRite of Wyckoff and some of the food prep will take place on Friday October 13th. The bulk of the food prep and serving in Hackensack is on Saturday October 14th. Two important notes: 1 - Servers no longer need to be vaccinated; 2 - We can send four people, 18 and older to Hackensack.

# This year, there are three ways to help:

- 1. Direct Donation: Visit https://www.sohm.org/bol2023 to donate money online. Star of Hope will use your donation to purchase food items to fill a box at their warehouse. A \$50 donation purchases a box of food. A \$22 donation purchases a turkey. Combined, you can provide a family a complete Thanksgiving meal! This option does not require you to shop or purchase food. You can also mail a check to Star of Hope Ministries, Inc., 34 Broadway, Paterson, NJ 07505.
- 2. Shop & Buy Supplies: Use the grocery list in the Bellringer or pick up a grocery list in the church or the office. Please purchase ALL items listed to complete a 'Box of Love'. Your completed list of items may be <u>dropped off in bags</u> in the office between 9:30am-2:30pm M-F, or during church hours from 9:30-11am on Sunday. Please return the bags by Friday, Oct. 27th. Our Sunday school children will package the food in boxes on Oct. 29. This option is highly encouraged for our young families!
- 3. Pack In Person: Finally, you can sign up online at: https://sohm.volunteerhub.com/vv2/lp/BoxofLove/ to help pack the boxes in the Star of Hope's warehouse at Grace Redeemer Church in Glen Rock, NJ. This is a fun option for people with flexible schedules! (This will be available later this week.)
