As they waited to celebrate Jesus' first coming, they practiced waiting for His second coming. As a result, it is a season of great devotion when Christians often take on new Spiritual Practices, or Disciplines. It's in that spirit that we offer an Advent Devotional to the community every year: to create space for prayer, contemplation, and whatever else the Spirit brings.
