ADDITIONAL VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY FOR WALK-IN DINNER - Family Promise is looking to increase the number of potential daily volunteers at the shelter in Hackensack. They run the program seven days a week, with eight or nine volunteers scheduled each day. This includes a Team Leader, four drivers, and three or four others to help pack and distribute the dinners that you are all providing. If you are interested, here are the details:

Family Promise maintains a list of volunteers, all of whom receive an email each Wednesday asking if they can volunteer the following week and on which day or days. Volunteers must be at least 18 years of age, fully vaccinated, and able to stay for the full shift, 3:15-6pm. Masks and hats are required. We provide gloves.
