EASTER SCHEDULE

KEEPING WATCH: TAKING EVERY HOUR CAPTIVE This Easter, we invite you to keep watch with us as we make our way from Good Friday to Easter Sunday. We will be sharing a devotional resource with you that will guide you through the Holy Weekend. This guide offers a set prayer and scripture reading every three hours to mark Jesus' death, rest in the grave, and glorious resurrection. The guide begins at Noon on Good Friday as Jesus is hung on the cross and invites you to pause every three hours until 6am on Easter Sunday as we celebrate the resurrection. You may want to set an alarm in your phone for 10-15 minutes prior to each time of prayer so that you can get ready. We encourage you to pray together with others in your home, if that is possible. Gather together in a set place. Consider doing something to set this time and space aside, perhaps lighting a candle and spending a few moments in silence before and after. The purpose of spending a few minutes in scripture and prayer every three hours isn't to say we did it; it's to charge the rest of our day with that same presence of God.

HOLY WEEK STATIONS OF THE CROSS

The Stations of the Cross started as a practice of pilgrims who walked the final steps of Jesus in Jerusalem and was eventually brought home for those who couldn't make the journey. The practice invites us to contemplate Jesus' death and resurrection more deeply and intimately. We invite the congregation and community to stop by the church at any point during Holy Week (4/10--4/18) to walk our outdoor Stations of the Cross installation from artist Scott Erickson. Start in front of the Education Building and follow the stations in order along the brick pathway to the sanctuary and back to the parking lot along the sidewalk. Take your time and pray as you go.
