JULY WALK-IN DINNER

The next walk-in dinner that Wyckoff Reformed Church will prepare and serve is on Saturday, July 23.

Thank you to everyone that has helped with this important mission in the past. Each time we prepare and serve a dinner, we need 10 or more volunteers.

Here are the ways you can help:

- 1. Pick up food and water at ShopRite on Friday.
- 2. Two people to prepare the salad Friday afternoon or evening.
- 3. Two people to cut potatoes into chunks at 9:00am on Saturday.
- 4. Two people to prepare the meatloaf at 10:15am on Saturday.
- 5. Thank you to Dave Collins for volunteering to cook the meatloaf, vegetables and potatoes in the church kitchen from 11:15 am 2:30 pm.
- 6. One person to pick up and cook one meatloaf tray at home 11:15am 2:00pm.
- 7. Three people to pick up the cooked food and supplies in the church kitchen, deliver it to the homeless shelter in Hackensack and stay and help place the food in containers. This commitment is from 2:15 6:00pm. These volunteers need to be 18 or older, sign a waiver form and need to show proof of vaccination. Volunteer names are needed by Monday, 7/11. If you have served already, your waiver form should be on file.
- 8. One person to come in at 2:00pm to help clean up the kitchen.
