DR. JOANNE J. NOEL

Dr. Joanne J. Noel loves God and loves people. Her life's motto is: My highest for his utmost. She is a graduate of New Brunswick Theological Seminary and Union Institute and University where she earned her MDIV and DMIN and Ph. D in Humanities and Culture, including certificates in Creative Writing and Women and Gender Studies.

With roots in the Caribbean Island of Trinidad & Tobago, she identifies her ministry as a "call to the nations" and as such she has preached, taught, and led workshops in various churches and parachurch organizations across the United States and the Caribbean in multiple denominations and among various people groups, cultures, races, and ethnicities.

Apart from being a dynamic and anointed speaker and teacher, Dr. Noel is a published author and columnist. She is co-author of *Tapping into Your Superpower* (2022) and *When Kids Pray* (2023). She is also one of the founding leaders of Faith Foundations Christian Ministry, a ministry that provides religious education, life skills and resources to under-resourced children in the Caribbean.

She has pastored two churches on an interim basis and has a vibrant itinerant ministry, very often responding to the cry "come over into Macedonia and help us."

She is currently an Associate Dean and Professor of English at Pillar College where she has held various positions, including Assistant Vice President of Academic Affairs, Dean of Traditional Undergraduate programs, Director of the Writing Center, and Director of Spiritual Formation.

Apart from being recognized by the Cathedral International and The Citadel Church for strong leadership and commitment to service, she has been acknowledged in *Marquis' Who's Who* as a leading educator, and in 2015 and 2018, Pillar College recognized her leadership and commitment to excellence in education by awarding her the 2015 and 2018 Distinguished Faculty and Excellence in Teaching Awards.

Additionally, she holds several awards, certificates, and accolades from various institutions including Union Institute and University, Queens College, Rutgers University and New Brunswick Theological Seminary.
