PRAYER FOR RENEWAL

PSALM 1

"The truly happy person
doesn't follow wicked advice,
doesn't stand on the road of sinners,
and doesn't sit with the disrespectful.
Instead of doing those things,
these persons love the Lord's Instruction,
and they recite God's Instruction day and night!
They are like a tree replanted by streams of water,
which bears fruit at just the right time
and whose leaves don't fade.

Whatever they do succeeds.

That's not true for the wicked!

They are like dust that the wind blows away.

And that's why the wicked will have no standing in the court of justice—neither will sinners in the assembly of the righteous.

The Lord is intimately acquainted with the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked is destroyed."

Lord, as we begin our Lenten journey, turn our hearts away from worthless things; keep our feet from the paths of sinners, keep our minds from the company of the wicked. But for your merciful hand, we would fall into destruction. So hold us and forgive our sin. Lead us by streams of living water and fill us with your Word-food and drink for the journey set before us-so that we would know you and love you, that we would bear good and lasting fruit in this aching world. In your name we pray. Amen.

IMPOSITION OF ASHES

In the Bible, ashes are a sign of our human mortality, as well as a sign of mourning and repentance. We receive the ashen sign of the cross tonight as a sign that we belong to Jesus, rely completely on his gift of grace, and are determined to turn back and live lives that are pleasing to him. To receive ashes, come forward down the center aisle. If you would like to receive ashes on the back of your hand instead of your forehead, please hold out your hand when you come forward.
